

## **School District of Greenfield Food Service Department Certifications**

**School District Of Greenfield requires the Food and Nutrition Director, Kitchen Manager and Coordinator, to be State of Wisconsin, Department of Health Services, Division of Public Health licensed with a Food Managers License.**

Greenfield Food and Nutrition recognizes the importance of licensing, credentials and certification. SDoG Food and Nutrition Department has trained 16 additional staff members with this accreditation. In all, the Food Service Director, Kitchen Manager, Food Service Coordinator, Kitchen Supervisor, Head Cooks and Lead Cooks and many Line Cooks also hold the State of Wisconsin Food Manager's License.

The holder of a Food Manager's License have been educated and trained in preventing foodborne illness, proper food sanitation and food safety in addition to the best practices for preparing and serving food.

**In addition, the school District of Greenfield Food and Nutrition Service has on staff 7 employees who are "SERVSAFE" certified.**

**The ServSafe Certification covers** basic food safety practices for preparing and serving food, foodborne illness prevention and proper food handling.

**Greenfield also has 7 employees who hold a Food Handlers Certification** which covers learning about basic food safety practices for preparing and serving food.

All three levels of licensing and/or certification are accredited through the National Restaurant Association
