ACP

Academic and Career Planning (ACP) is a collaboratively developed, student-driven process for planning for success in middle school, secondary school, and post-secondary academics and career development.

***Wisconsin Statute 115.28(59) Signed June 28, 2013

Authorizes DPI to create administrative rule with requirements for ACP services for all students in grades 6-12 by 2017-18.

ACP Process Components

----KNOW-EXPLORE-PLAN-GO-----

KNOW

- Self awareness & exploration activities
- Individual goal-setting

EXPLORE

- Career awareness assessment
- Career research & postsecondary training options
- Connect a student's middle and high school instructional activities with the education and preparation needed to successfully enter a particular field of interest





ACP Process Components

PLAN

- Work-based learning opportunities
- Extra-curricular and community-based learning
- Financial plan to cover cost of postsecondary training

• **GO**

- Adapt/Modify regularly
 - Intentional Sequence of Courses
 - Personal Goals
 - Career Goals
- ACP Conferencing

 - Adding tab to the District website with ACP links and resources
- Seek Feedback from staff regarding activities/experiences currently in place.

- Reinforce tools to facilitate the process-Use of Career Cruising
- ullet Career Cruising is one tool now in place for students in the District ${f V}$
 - Targeted staff attended training
 - Students in grades 6-11 are taking "Matchmaker" in Career Cruising
 - Counselors at the HS & MS level are introducing this tool to parents with students at 8th & 11th grade conferencing

- Highlight connections with the Pathways to Success, the Sure Six, and G21.
- Continue to refine and expand resources for students tied to coursework and experiences
- Continue ongoing monthly small group and full team meetings to continue this process for students in Greenfield.
